<u>PROCESS</u> The actions or steps taken to obtain a person to be trafficked.	<u>WAYS/MEANS</u> Methods used to keep a person in the trafficking process.	<u>GOAL</u> The reason or purpose for trafficking a person.
<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Recruitment</i> The process of attracting and selecting persons for a specific purpose.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Transportation</i> A system or means of moving persons from place to place by means of a vehicle, aircraft, or ship.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Transferring</i> Moving a person from one place to another place.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Harboring</i> Secretly keeping a person in a specific place.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Receiving</i> Having a person delivered or brought to another person.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Threat</i> A statement of an intention to inflict pain, injury, damage, or other hostile action on a person, or his/her family, in retribution for something done or not done.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Coercion</i> Persuading someone to do something by using force or threats.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Abduction</i> Forcibly taking someone away against their will.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Fraud</i> Lies or false promises used to trick a person in order to take advantage of him/her.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Deceit</i> Concealing or distorting the truth for the purpose of misleading a person.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Deception</i> An action or statement intended to make a person believe something that is not true.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Abuse of Power</i> Getting a person to do what you want through the ability to punish or hurt them, or their family, if they do not comply.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Prostitution</i> Sexual activity with someone for money.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Pornography</i> Movies, pictures, magazines, that show naked persons or people having sex in a very open and direct way in order to cause sexual excitement.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Violence/Sexual Exploitation</i> The sexual abuse of children and youth through the exchange of sex or sexual acts for drugs, food, shelter, protection, other basics of life, and/or money. Sexual exploitation includes involving children and youth in creating pornography and sexually explicit websites.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Forced Labor</i> Any work or services which people are forced to do against their will under the threat of some form punishment.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Involuntary Servitude</i> Any work or services people are forced to do against their will for the payment of a debt.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Debt Bondage (With Unfair Wages)</i> Working for the repayment of a real or alleged debt, but the victim's wages are not reasonably applied toward the payment of the debt, or there is no limit or defined length of the victim's services.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Slavery</i> Persons paid for and owned by another person and forced to work for that person without pay.</p>
